

BOIL WATER NOTIFICATION
NUECES COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT #3

Due to the winter storm conditions which have occurred recently in the water system of the Nueces County Water Control and Improvement District #3, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has required the system to notify all customers to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking and ice making should be boiled and cooled prior to consumption. The water should be brought to vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source. When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, water system officials will notify you.
