

## **Fire Hydrant/Construction Meter Use Agreement**

The meter deposit is \$2,500.00 for all development/long term projects plus a \$50 non-refundable installation fee.

The monthly minimum (base rate) will be the District's current Standard Water Rate for a 3" water meter.

The Water consumption rate shall apply at the current published rate.

- 1. The meter and all appurtenances (backflow devices, valves, fittings, etc.) shall be, and remain the property of the District.
- 2. Meters shall not be assigned or subleased to anyone at any time.
- 3. The meter shall only be utilized within the District boundaries.
- 4. The person signing for this meter at the time of issue by the District shall be the responsible party.
- 5. All meter and or fire hydrant damage including missing parts will be deducted from the deposit. In the event the meter is lost or stolen the entire deposit shall be forfeited.
- 6. Tampering with the meter or use of the meter on another water system constitutes theft of service and will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
- 7. The responsible party shall provide a monthly reading to the District on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month or the next business day following that date.
- 8. Payment of water usage is due by the due date on the water bill. In the event the bill is not paid by the due date the meter may be removed from the jobsite and all charges applied to the deposit.
- 9. The responsible party agrees that the water purchased from the District pursuant to this agreement shall be used for construction purposes only. The responsible party further agrees to indemnify, save and hold the District, its Board of Directors, management, consultants

and employees, harmless from any and all claims, actions or causes of action arising out of or having to do with the responsible party's purchase and use of the water being purchased pursuant to this agreement.

• In the event the meter needs to be moved to another fire hydrant location permission must be granted by the District.
