The District would like to inform you that the water quality concerns involving the TTHM issues have been addressed and corrected. The District is totally committed to providing its customers the best quality of water possible.

We are regulated by State agencies and must follow all their requirements regarding process changes and notifications.

With that being said you will receive one last notice of excessive TTHM levels as required by the State. The State requires us to use a yearly average in reporting the values. I can assure you that the issue has been corrected and our last two sets of samples have been well below the MCL limits on TTHM's. With the average calculating below the limits after our last two sets of samples taken notifications will no longer be required.

Again the District is committed to providing its customers the best water quality possible and we remain strong on that commitment. Please know that our staff will continue to monitor and correct any water quality issues that may occur due to changing concerns in our source waters.
